Gibson Bay Golf Course is a 7,100 yard, par 72 course, located along Richmond's 450 acre Lake Reba recreational complex. There are up to five tee boxes on each hole. All tees, greens, and fairways are seeded with bent grass to provide the best possible playing conditions. Gibson Bay is a long, open golf course which allows gusts of wind to be a factor in shot-making. A player will not find much trouble off the tee, but wayward tee shots will lead to side-hill lies and an awkward approach shot. Many of the greens are set into hill sides and protected by strategically placed bunkers and mounding.

## What Is Special Olympics?

**Special Olympics mission** is to provide year-round sports training and athletic competition in a variety of Olympic-type sports for children and adults with intellectual disabilities, giving them continuing opportunities to develop physical fitness, demonstrate courage, experience joy and participate in a sharing of gifts, skills and friendship with their families, other Special Olympics athletes and the community.

**Special Olympics Kentucky offers...**training and competition in 15 sports including alpine skiing, aquatics, basketball, bocce, bowling, cheerleading, equestrian, figure skating, flag football, golf, gymnastics, snow shoeing, soccer, softball and track and field. Athletes learn fundamental, rules and strategies from their coaches during a training period prior to competition. Approximately 235 competitions are held each year at the local, regional and state levels. Over 8,900 athletes participate yearly. Kentucky is divided into nine regions, each with a Local Coordinator for fundraising and administration. Not all sports have national level competition but, for the sports that do, an event is held on an annual basis. World Games are held every two years with winter and summer games alternating.

**The program helps...**Special Olympics athletes enhance their physical fitness and motor skills, build self-confidence, friendships and social skills. Special Olympics athletes carry these benefits with them into their daily lives at home, in the classroom, on the job and in the community. Families who participate become stronger as they learn a greater appreciation of their athlete's abilities.



Volunteers help in every aspect of the program and derive great satisfaction from contact with the athletes and their families. Everyone in the community respects and learns about the capabilities of people with intellectual disabilities.
